

PWF Grant Awards - 2010

In 2010, Portland Women's Foundation granted **\$190,695** to **25** organizations which provide housing and education services to help women become self-sufficient.

- PWF maintained its practice of **funding operating expenses** – critical to small programs continuing to successfully serve their clients.
- PWF also gave \$8,945 to TACS to **provide valuable technical assistance** support to our grantees.
